Powel Elementary School & Science Leadership Academy Middle School Philadelphia, PA

The project was a collaboration of the Philadelphia school district Samuel Powel Elementary School, the Science Leadership Academy, and Drexel University. This K-8 facility is approximately 87,000 sf over two stories and can accommodate 720 students.

PrecisCx provided paperless commissioning for the systems and equipment associated with this project. PrecisCx also developed and implemented a Commissioning Project Plan, confirmed incorporation of the Cx requirements in the construction documents and schedule, developed and executed installation checklists, developed and executed system test procedures, maintained and issues log, and prepared a final cx report. PrecisCx also witnessed selected system startups, duct & piping pressure tests, and reviewed the TAB report.

Close coordination of commissioning with the Construction Manager was required to assure issues were addressed in a timely manner as the project had to be completed prior to the start of the school year.
